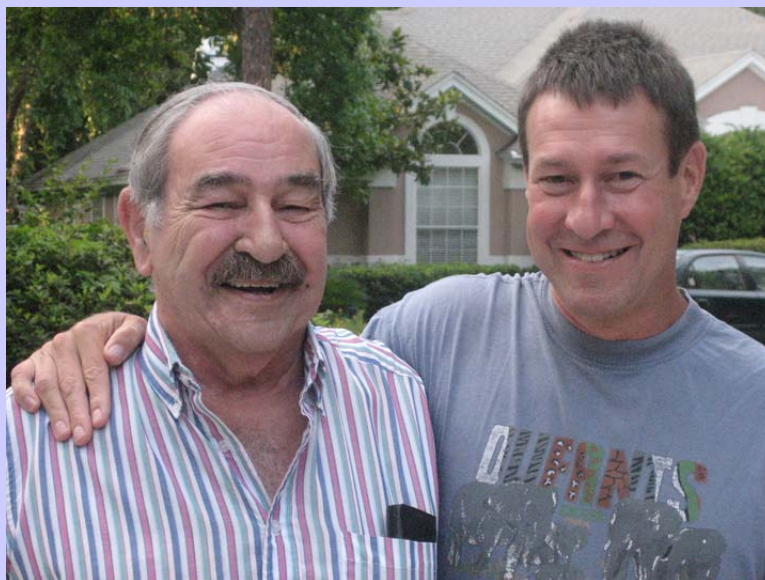


A Tribute to Allen Steinhauer
